



Lesson Observation







• Lesson observation refers to a formal scrutiny of teaching/learning while it is taking place in a classroom or other learning environment.

• In this target, a teacher is required to be observed while delivering a lesson at least once a term.



How to undertake Lesson Observation in the TPAD Online System

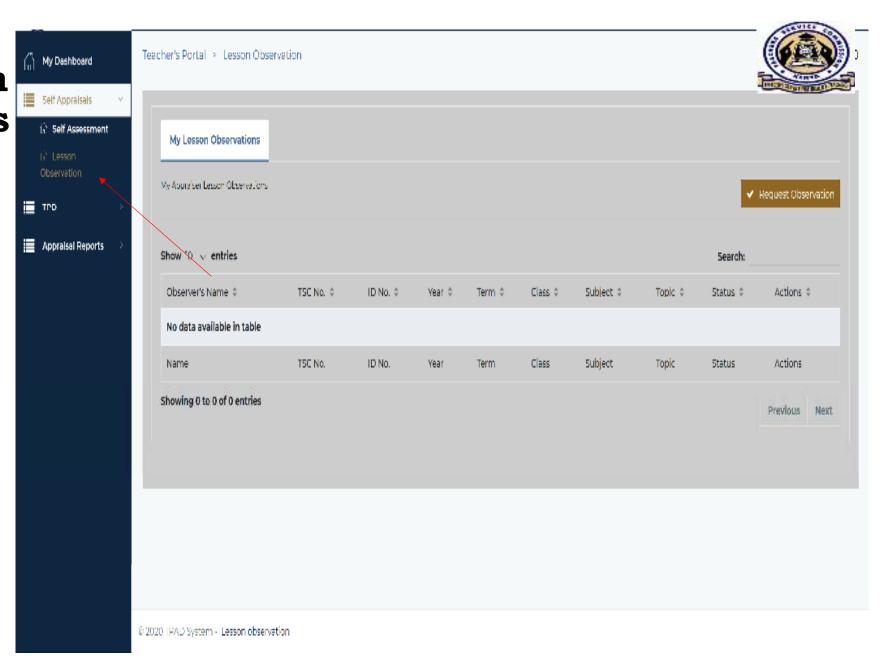


• The lesson Observation tab can be found under the self appraisals tab for the appraisees.



Lesson observation (appraisee's page)

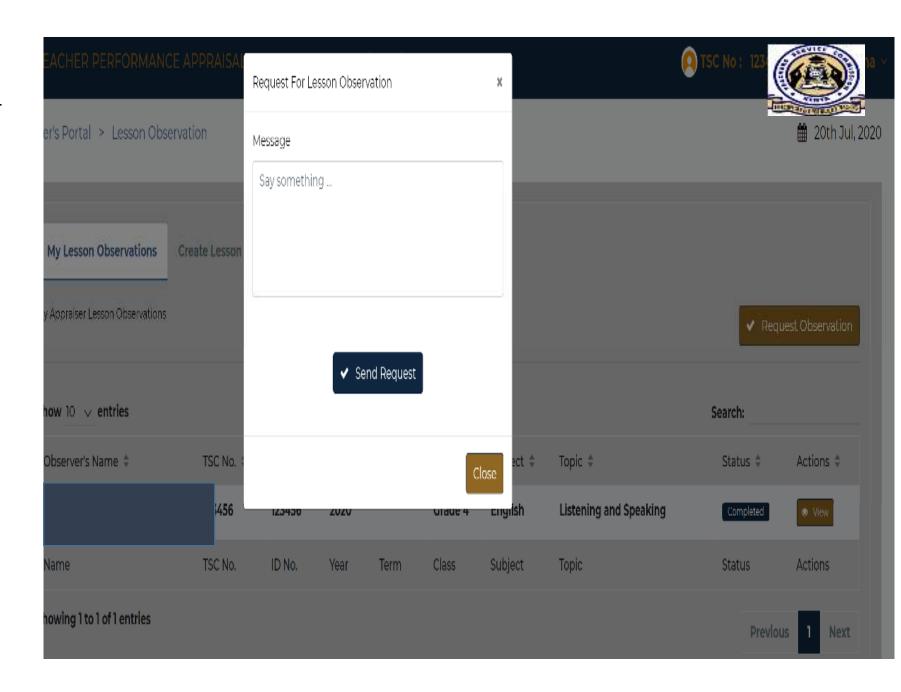
The appraisee can locate the lesson observation under the lesson observation tab





Request for observation


The appraisee can send the appraiser a request to be observed by clicking on REQUEST OBSERVATION tab.





The appraiser is required to click on New Record whereby he/she will be required to add data on :


- Class/Form

STEP IV:


The appraiser is required to fill in the blank areas as shown in the page and then ADD

RECORD






Once the data is added, the page showing that it is successful will appear





Once the data is added, the page /interface will show the record as follows:













Once the observer has filled in the data, he/she can save the observation marks
